

- The oxygen in the blood provides fuel for the muscles and organs.
- The heart then pumps the oxygenated blood around the body.
- The lungs remove carbon dioxide from the blood and replace it with oxygen from the air we breathe.
- The blood returns to the heart to begin the cycle again.
- The heart pumps blood to the lungs.
