The spelling test continues to be on Wednesday morning, new spellings will also be set on Spelling Shed on Wednesdays to be practised at home. Please encourage your child to use Spelling Shed, it is an excellent resource.

### Homework:

I post the week's homework on the blog and this is sometimes a sheet to take home or it could be a task on Mathletics, Purple Mash or an attached sheet / task.

Homework will be set every Friday and it is due in the following Thursday.

Y3 homework consists of one piece of work, alternating between Maths one week and English the next.

Children will also need to practise spellings and times tables for the weekly tests and read regularly at home. There will also be Creative Homework for some topics, which the children usually really enjoy as they involve an element of choice.

Reading:

Please encourage your child to read at home. Regular practise is essential for them to develop fluency and comprehension skills.

We continue to hear readers 1-1, as well as a daily guided reading session.

**Other Information:**

Water Bottles: Please provide a named water bottle every day. This is especially important as the weather warms up.
